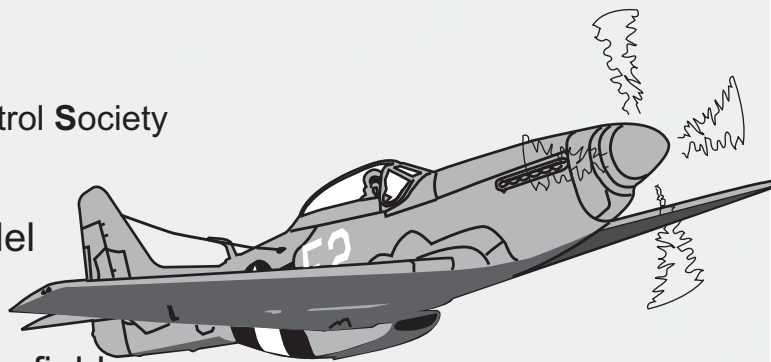


MARKS Club

Behind this name, there is an active RC model club that is located in the **San Bernardino - Redlands - Highland area in Southern California**. We currently have one main flying field which is located on Greenspot Road about three miles east of the City of Highland. This field features a large polymer runway capable of handling everything from very small to giant size planes. Also, during Winter and Spring, a beautiful lake, directly adjacent to the field, provides an optimal site for float flying.

The Greenspot Project

We are building a new RC Flying Site!

Late in December 2007 we received the green light from the BLM to build our new runway in Greenspot (close to the city of Highland). – The new location is ideally suited for an RC flying site:

- The sun is always at our backs
- The runway is in the main wind direction (W to E)
- The area is sheltered from Santa Ana winds and will provide year round flying opportunities
- In its finished state the new site will feature an 800' x 55' runway, an extended system of taxiways, a large shaded area, a tower and observations platform, a large parking area, and a dedicated area for 3D flying. – What an awesome field!

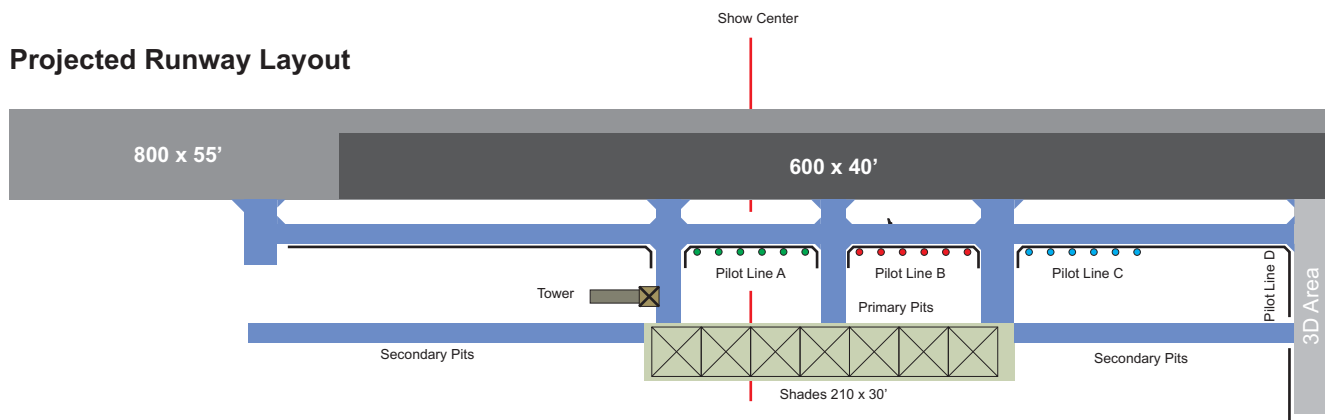
