

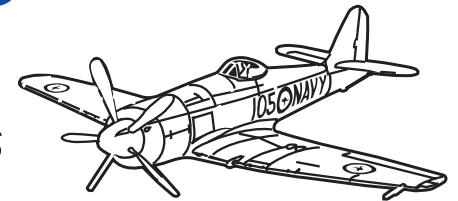
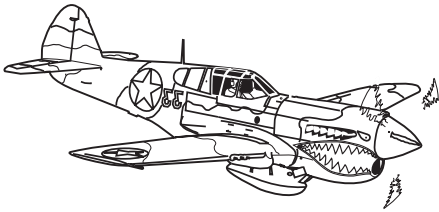


The MARKS Club
